CSBS Internship

There are three graded elements in this internship.

(1) (Approximately) Weekly Reports: You will submit through Canvas ten reports describing your work: what your tasks were, the number of hours you put in, and a brief reflection on what you've learned or what new questions you have as a result of your work. (This should be one or two paragraphs per week.) These can be either uploaded files or direct text entries in the relevant assignment area in Canvas. Due dates are found under "assignments." Each report is worth 3 points (30 points total).

(2) Research Project: Consulting with Professor Maloney, you will develop a 10-page research paper on a topic related to your work. Your paper must draw on at least six academic sources (journal articles or books). You will turn in a brief proposal – one paragraph, an outline, and a list of at least six potential sources, on March 3. You will turn in a rough draft on April 14. The final paper will be due on April 28. More details (citation format, etc.) are provided in the "assignment" boxes. These should all be submitted as files uploaded in Canvas. The proposal is worth 10 points. The rough draft is worth 15. The final paper is worth 25. (50 points total)

(3) Evaluation by Internship Host: PLEASE ARRANGE WITH JACQUELINE BROIDA, THE COLLEGE INTERNSHIP ADVISOR, TO HAVE A RELEVANT WORK SUPERVISOR PROVIDE A FINAL EVALUATION OF YOUR WORK. Jacqueline will contact the supervisor and administer the evaluation survey. This should be completed and submitted by May 5. 20 points.
